Meeting called to order

Board of Education President, Mr. Hoch, called the meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.

Notice of Meeting

The meeting was properly noticed by posting the notice of the meeting at the Durand Public Library, at the Durand High School, and at Caddie Woodlawn.

Executive Session 19.85(1)(a) and 19.85(1)(f)

Motion made by Mr. Wittig and seconded by Mrs. Baldini to convene into executive session in accordance with state statute 19.85(1)(a) and 19.85(1)(f). Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Motion made by Mrs. Myers and seconded by Mrs. Hoyt to expel the student from the School District of Durand through the age of twenty-one. Student will have the option for completion of the necessary credits toward graduation. Student will also have the option for early reinstatement at the beginning of the first semester of the 2009-10 school year subject to all of the following conditions: (1) Student must enroll and satisfactorily complete "Corrective Thinking" counseling at the family's expense; (2) Student is required to enroll and actively participate in Anger Management Counseling at the family's expense through a mutually agreed upon counseling program; (3) Student must actively participate and complete all programming prospectively imposed by Pepin County Human Services or any other agency as a result of his referral; (4) Student will not possess anything that can be construed as a dangerous weapon on school grounds or at any school sponsored event; and (5) Student will be permitted to continue his academic coursework as determined by the administrative team and pupil services team. It is further ordered that the student be precluded from being present on school premises for any purpose during the term of the expulsion, including attendance at all co-curricular activities and other events on school premises, without regard to whether such activities or events are otherwise open to the general public, unless he has obtained prior administrative approval to do so. Motion carried by a unanimous roll call vote.

Motion to Return to Open Session

Motion made by Mrs. Baldini and seconded by Mrs. Hoyt to return to open session. Motion carried by a unanimous voice vote.

Adjournment
